



# SAMPLE BALLOT

You then have the option of making another choice.</p>  <p><b>Optional Write-In</b> To add a candidate, fill in the oval to the left of the blank line and print the name clearly on the line.</p>  <p><b>Vote for only one choice for each office or ballot measure, unless the office or ballot measure specifically states otherwise. This measure would require most raw agricultural commodities, processed foods, and seeds and seed stocks, if produced using genetic engineering, as defined, to be labeled as genetically engineered when offered for retail sale.
