Each political party declaration, with an accompanying checkbox, shall be printed on the 2024 Presidential Primary return envelope with the standard ballot declaration required by WAC 434-219-155. Any registered voter desiring to participate in the Presidential Primary of a major party shall subscribe to the appropriate declaration.
