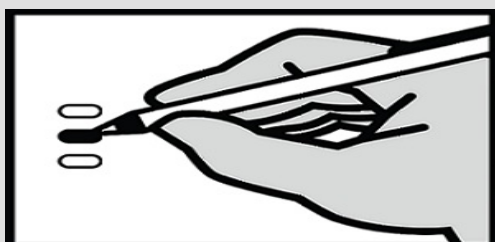


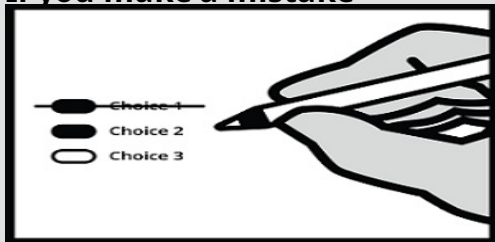
Instructions

How to Vote



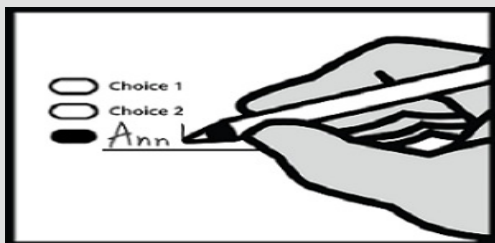
Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice. Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

City of Newport Property Tax for Fire Protection Services

The Newport City Council adopted Amended Resolution No. 20230717 concerning a proposition for an additional property tax for fire protection services. If approved, this proposition would authorize the City to assess an additional \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value, for a total levy rate of \$2.66, for collection in 2024 and thereafter, which amount will be used for computing legal limits on levies in subsequent years pursuant to Chapter 84.55RCW, and the additional funds are intended to be used to maintain the current level of fire protection services.
