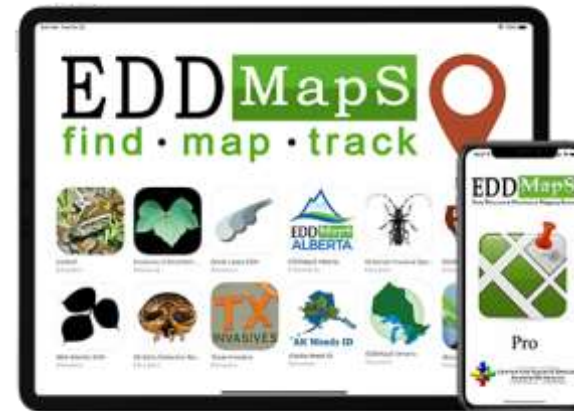

Technical Assistance

1. Free phone or on-site consultations
2. Regenerative Ag. Or Forestry Management Plans
3. Soil Health Sampling (Fees may apply)
4. Equipment Rentals (No-Till Seeder)
5. EDDS Maps (includes riparian site-visits)

Any of these services can include strategies for managing invasive weeds on your farm or property.

These services are typically at NO-COST to the landowner or farmer (exception soil health sampling outside of the Soil Health Initiative).



Cost-Share Programs

What is this?

1. Any qualifying agricultural or landowner project will be allotted a percentage of the project cost from the specified grant program
2. The conservation district acts as a pass-through for many Federal and State Cost-Share Programs they will vary every Fiscal year (July-June)
3. Free Money?...Maybe.

Direct Invasive Weed Cost-Share Program

Department Of Ecology

- Aquatic Invasive Plants Management Program
- Should be open early fall
- Manage milfoil and other invasive species on lakes, rivers & streams

Pend Oreille County Weed Board

- ▶ Check-in with the POCWB on current or future subsidized programs.

Other Cost-Share Options to help manage invasive Weeds

- ▶ Most programs at the conservation district DO NOT directly cost-share on invasive weeds, However, if invasive weeds are an impediment to an existing cost-share project there would be an ability to use funds for this purpose.
