Draft Natural Resource Designations' Criteria

Natural Resource - Federal: Parcels owned by a federal agency and not managed for another purpose (such as Parks and Recreation). Can be any size.

Natural Resource - State: Parcels owned by a state agency and not managed for another purpose (such as Parks and Recreation). Can be any size.

Natural Resource: Parcels enrolled in the timber and/or agricultural tax program that are larger than 10 acres. Or parcels of any size owned by local agencies (County, PUD, Seattle City Light) that do not fit into any other future land use desingation. Each parcel owned by a local public agency was checked to see its most appropriate designation.
