


Instructions

How to Vote




Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice. Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

Special Election - Proposition No.1 Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services

The Board of SOUTH PEND OREILLE FIRE & RESCUE adopted Resolution No. 4.20.2023A concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition authorizes the District to establish its regular property tax levy at \$1.25 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2023 and collected in 2024. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection, emergency medical services and facilities, replace apparatus and equipment, and provide for firefighter safety. The maximum allowable levy in 2023 (collected in 2024) shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
